Course and Clubhouse Etiquette

We would like to extend a warm welcome to all our guests and ask you to take the time to note and observe the following:

Tournament Dress Code

Members, guests and visitors are expected to maintain a reasonable standard of dress at all times in the clubhouse and on the golf course.

The following items of dress are not to be worn:

On the Golf Course: Camouflage Type Trousers or Shorts, Tracksuits, Sleeveless or Non-Golfing Collarless Shirts, Football or Rugby Type Tops.

All the above, plus Hats, Caps, Visors, Waterproof trousers may not be worn in all Public Areas i.e. Foyer, Lounge, Dining Room etc. Golf shoes must be worn on the golf course.

The staff have been instructed to ensure these brief regulations are adhered to and we ask for your full co-operation in this regard. If you require any clarification or further information, please check with the Admin office.

Mobile Telephones

On the golf course Mobile telephones may not be used on the golf course unless in an emergency situation or if they are being used as a measuring device.

We have free Wi-Fi in the clubhouse under the name EGC Guest with a password: holeinone.

To ensure that members and visitors are not disturbed while in the clubhouse, persons in possession of a mobile telephone are asked not to have conversations on the phone and should conduct this outside the lounge.

Slow Play – Ready Golf

The Club have adopt the practice of "Ready Golf" . If you require further information please contact the Pro Shop. Players are asked to show courtesy for fellow players by avoiding slow play. Groups playing in threes should complete the course in no more than 4 hours.

Children are welcome in the clubhouse during the 5 day open.

- Practice Round Sunday
- Strokeplay qualifying rounds on Monday and Tuesday.
- Top 16 scratch scores qualify for Gents scratch matchplay.
- Top 64 handicap scores qualify for the two handicap Gents matchplay competitions.
- Top 8 Seniors handicap scores qualify for the Alan Milne Seniors Shield.
- Matchplay takes place over Wednesday, Thursday and Friday with the Finals to be held on Friday afternoon.
- 18 Hole Qualifying Round for the Consolation JAG Innes Cup Competition will take place on Wednesday where players returning the best eight nett scores will qualify for the matchplay stages to be played on Thursday & Friday.
- Entry to JAG Innes Cup is automatic with times allocated Tuesday evening based on nett scores from the qualifying rounds
- 18 Hole Consolation Stableford Competition will be held on Thursday for Gents.
- 4-Man Team Texas Scramble on Friday.

The 5 Day Open Tournament Director will be John Duguid, Elgin Golf Club Manager, who will be responsible for making decisions and settling disputes, such decisions and settlements being final.
