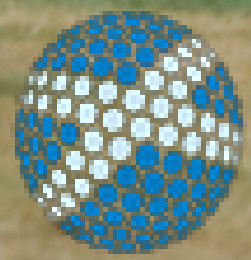

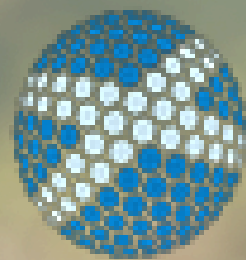

**ELGIN GOLF CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1906, STARTING AS A 9-HOLE COURSE ON WEDNESDAY 8TH MAY 1907. THE FIRST GREEN-KEEPER, JOHN MACPHERSON, APPOINTED IN 1907, SERVED CONTINUOUSLY UNTIL HIS SUDDEN DEATH IN 1951. DURING THAT PERIOD MR MACPHERSON DEVOTED HIS WHOLE LIFE TO MAINTAINING THE COURSE.**

**THE COURSE WAS EXTENDED TO 18 HOLES IN 1924, AND GOLF AT THIS TIME WAS SO POPULAR THE MEMBERSHIP ROSE TO 711. THE FIRST CLUB PROFESSIONAL WAS APPOINTED IN 1934, AND THE LONGEST SERVING BY FAR WAS IAN RODGER WHO WAS IN POST FOR 27 YEARS, RETIRING IN MARCH 2001.**

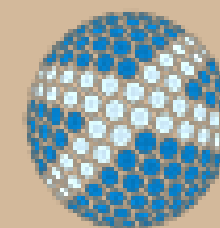

Tuesday 14th July 2026 using a random number generator.**

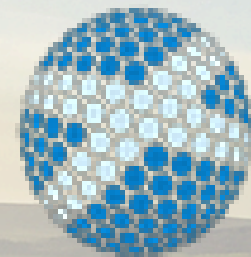
**A square will be drawn for each of the 16 qualifiers and

## QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- Top 16 Gross Scores Qualify for Kynoch Shand Cup
- Top 64 Nett Scores Qualify for Handicap Matchplays
- Top 8 Seniors Nett Scores qualify for Alan Milne Seniors Shield (entry must be declared at registration)
- Matchplay takes place over Wednesday, Thursday and Friday with the finals to be held on Friday afternoon
- 18 Hole Qualifying Round for the Consolation JAG Innes Cup. The competition will take place on Wednesday, where players returning the best 8 nett scores will qualify for the matchplay stages to be played over the Thursday & Friday
- Entry to the JAG Innes Cup is automatic with Tee Times allocated Tuesday evening based on nett scores from initial qualifying
- 18 Hole Consolation Stableford on Thursday - booking available on Wednesday
- 4-person Texas Scramble on Friday - booking available from Thursday
